

Campaign Explainer

Right now, the United States is experiencing an unprecedented expansion of the immigration detention system.

People across the country are joining the call to shut down detention centers, stop expansion, and free them all to protect immigrant family members, friends, coworkers, and neighbors.

Detention Watch Network's (DWN)
Communities Not Cages campaign
amplifies the longstanding local
organizing of DWN members, advocates,
and allies across the country, while
building a nationally coordinated strategy
to ultimately abolish the detention
system in its entirety.

Why detention?

Detention plays a crucial role in enabling Trump's mass deportation agenda: Detention puts people's lives in jeopardy, isolates people from their loved ones and support networks, coerces people to sign their deportation order, and facilitates the logistics of deportations. Communities with detention centers has higher rates of Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) arrests: shutting down detention centers can make it harder for ICE to deport our loved ones.

Why now?

The Trump administration is dangerously moving full steam ahead with its cruel detention and deportation agenda if Trump's multi-layered detention expansion is realized, it will triple the immigration detention system's capacity, tearing apart tens of thousands more people from their families and communities.

Stop Detention Expansion

Support local communities to organize and block detention expansion. Expansion threats include local jails, private prisons, federal prisons, and military bases such as Guantanamo Bay being converted to immigration detention



Uplift Communities

- Pass state legislation to block new detention center contracts
- Invest in programs that benefit everyone such as affordable housing, education, and health care and divest from detention and deportation
- Advocate for just closures


The campaign supports local fights by hosting national calls for participants to share updates, lessons, resources and analysis.
